SUBJECT: CSU General Education Breadth Requirements  
Revised December 3, 2020

The policy on the California State University General Education Breadth (CSU GE Breadth) requirements has been revised, effective December 3, 2020 and is available at <https://calstate.policystat.com/policy/8919100/latest/>. This policy supersedes Executive Order 1100-Revised, which was issued on August 23, 2017 and incorporates changes required as a result of AB 1460 (Education Code Section 89032). Additionally, the revised policy updates some elements related to transfer and articulation (Article 5), in response to recommendations from a variety of sources.

In accordance with California State University policy, the campus president has the responsibility for implementing CSU policies where applicable and for maintaining the campus repository and index for all CSU policies. 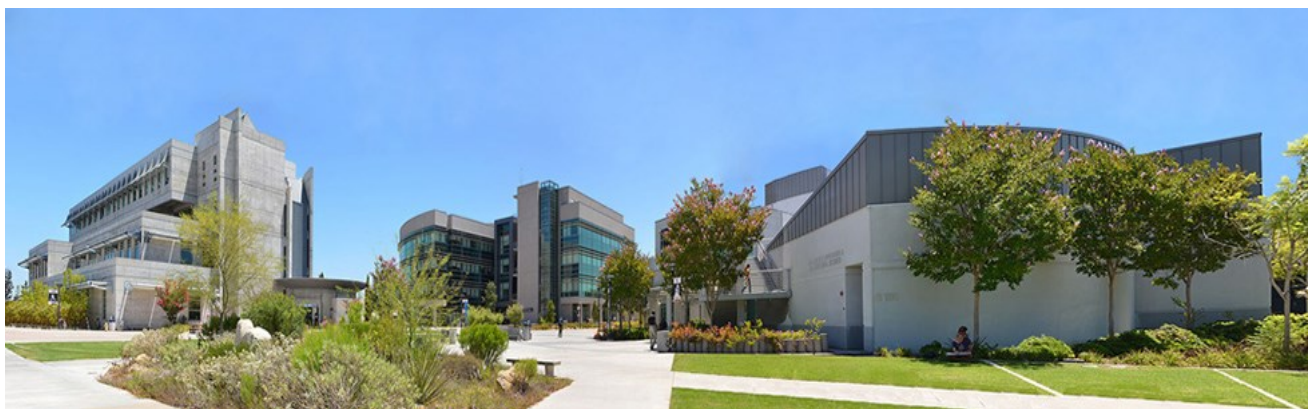
